"Two-in-one" solution for twice the security


The two control options combined in one product provide twice the security. In the "assigned use" operating mode, "Capio TA03 RFID MIFARE" enables two-factor authentication. To lock or open a locker, it is necessary to present an RFID transponder or smartphone as well as enter a PIN code – a feature that's recommended when it comes to applications where security needs to be provided for items that are particularly worth protecting.

Completing the trio in the "Capio" product family is a separate RFID reader which offers the same features as all of the familiar Lehmann RFID readers and supports both "MIFARE" as well as "LEGIC" technology.

Their outer appearance clearly shows that all three products belong together. Consistent product design with handle function provides an element of recognition and, together with the Lehmann-specific operating and configuration concept, enhances user friendliness. Given a broad range of colours for the various components, "Capio" products can also be customised in any chosen way.
